

SH 146 and City Update

SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

- Widen from 4 lane with center-turn-lane to 6-lanes with 4-lane express lanes and 2 2-lane frontage road • Projected construction cost \$201M
- Project Let May 2018
- Construction Start February 13th, 2019
- Project duration originally 5 years
- Anticipated completion in 4 years (May 2023)

Phases

TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Phase 1: Current Phase (Feb 2019 to Sept 2021*) Widen existing NB Clear Creek bridge and build new NB Frontage Road in Seabrook

Phase 2: Current Phase (July 2020 to July 2022*)

Widen existing SB Clear Creek bridge, build new SB Frontage Road, and build majority of new Express bridge

Phase 3: (August 2020 to Feb 2023*)

Reconstruct and elevate existing SH 146 mainlanes and build new NB Frontage Road in Kemah

Phase 4: (July 2020 to April 2023*) Finish new Express bridge, finish SB Frontage Road in Kemah




• Storm Sewer and utilities almost complete

- New Northbound Frontage Road in progress
- Southbound Frontage Road to follow after Northbound
- After traffic placed on new frontage road, main lanes in Seabrook will be closed, demolished, and rebuilt




Approximately 4.5 miles of roadway including:

- 2.39 miles of new bridge
- 0.71 miles of bridge widening
- 133 Utility Conflicts including:
 - 9 pipeline adjustments
 - City Water Line
 - City Wastewater Line
 - Centerpoint
 - Fiber


Old Draw Bridge Foundation in Conflict with NB Bridge Widening






Northbound Bridge Deck Est Completion Summer 2021

Seabrook Boat Ramp Relocation



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
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
Proposed Seabrook Boat Ramps are located at former Outrigger's Proposed work requires new roadway access from Bath Avenue







